





The Rifle Volunteer movement began in 1859, in response to a general perception that the country was open to a foreign invasion. Though this never materialized the Rifle Volunteers Movement continued until 1908, when Haldane's Army reforms incorporated them into the Territorial Army."

"This was a serious thing, for none felt safe with a man who could miss the object he aimed at by 15 or 20 feet in a hundred yards; while, on the other hand, Kyezor was too useful a member in getting subscriptions and recruits, to be discharged. What then was to be done? In a happy moment it was decided that Private Kyezor should be promoted to Quartermaster Sergeant and a sword substituted for the rifle, and so for a time Kyezor was made happy."






# -Emigration to Canada Passenger Logbook




To the right is the Tunisian, an Allan line ship that made weekly voyages from Liverpool to Quebec, Canada.



The Tunisian's Passenger Logbook shows that Leonard Keysor left Liverpool on 24 September 1903. His occupation at the time was a Clerk. The logbook says that he was 18 years old, though he was actually 17 at the time. He arrived in Quebec on 02 October 1903 before moving on to Shellmouth, Manitoba.


